All People attending the event must check in with the QR Code for the event. Burpengary Pony Club COVID Safe Plan can be viewed at the office on the day of competition. If you are unwell please stay home. Practice social distancing and wash hands regularly and use hand sanitizing stations around the grounds. Practice good BIO-Security practices. Mobile Phones must not be used by riders when mounted.



Conditions of Entry – Zone 26 One Day Event 29th & 30th May 2021

- Cross Country course is open for walking Saturday 29th from 2pm, no motorised equipment on course for walking unless approved by the TD or OC.
- Completed Horse Health Declaration to be handed in to the office when collecting Back Numbers.
- All Riders must wear current level Body Protectors and Medical Armbands on the cross country phase check that you have the current level BETA 2018 Level 3, BETA 2009 Level 3, EN13158:2009 Level 3, EN13158:2018 Level 3 (Jan 2021)
- Run under PCQ Rules open to PCQ Members only. This is a Zone 26 ODE. Is only open to Zone 26 riders. In the event it is opened to outside zones riders outside of Zone are HC. This event is Run in conjunction with the EA ODE.
- As a condition of entry, each rider **MUST** provide a helper either fence steward, dressage penciller, show jump set up
- Riders may enter a second competitive horse but if in the same section you need to consider ride times will be close.
- The cross country course is closed from midnight Sunday 2nd May 2021.
- Competitors must compete in full pony club uniform and also be in uniform to collect awards.
- Disclaimer: Neither the organising committee of any contest to which these rules apply, nor the PCQ, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- The Organising committee reserves the right to (a) cancel any class or event (b) to divide any class (c) to alter the advertised times (d) to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors
- Refunds – Only before close of entries. After close of entries 21st May 2021, refunds only with receipt of a veterinary or medical certificate less a \$25 administration fee. No Refunds for nomination fee after draw is published. In the event of COVID restrictions or an extreme weather event there will be an administration fee held if event is cancelled.
- First Aid is in Attendance – Canteen will be open for Breakfast and Lunch
- Points earned by Zone 26 competitors in this event contribute to Zone champion awards in accordance with the rules set by Zone 26 and Sub Committees. Senior riders must stipulate height competing as per PCQ Horse Trials Rule Book p21 Rule 13
- Official 12 yrs & Under riders may compete on any grade of horse provided that it is their normal pony club mount
- Riders in classes 1 – 7 must produce performance cards to the office prior to 8am on day of competition unless other arrangements have been made with the organising committee. . If rider does not have performance card on the day of competition, ribbons and trophies are withheld until it is produced. Nominations that do not have Horse Registration number and riders who do not have performance card on the day, will compete HC
- Riders cannot choose to upgrade on the day of the competition. This must be applied for and approved prior to the competition. Riders **MUST** compete in the class that is on their card. Those with an Introductory card, may also compete in Pre-Introductory (Sect 8c). A horse is allowed to ride down one level from that stated on the performance card without penalty. If the horse competes at two or more levels down from what it has on its performance card, ten penalties will be added to its total.
- Seniors nominating in Preliminary or above, must be competing in this level at EA events. If horse/rider are riding up from Introductory for the first time, then copies of 3 MERs need to be supplied to the Club with the nomination. If rider/horse has no previous eventing history, Senior is to compete in Pre-Introductory or Introductory only (preferably Pre-Intro).
- Jump Judges Briefing is at 7.00am at the Office on Sunday 30th May 2021 and the Riders Briefing is at 7.00am on Sunday 30th May at the Indoor arena. These will also be advised on the draw. Draw will be emailed and on the Burpengary Pony Club FB Page.
